



## Law Enforcement Officers & Active Military

Duty rigs and open carry are fine. We ask that you are identifiable through your clothing or uniform when entering the facility. Badge out if you are wearing unmarked polo shirts.

If you are not on duty and carrying concealed, keep it that way. Let us know who you are so we may respect your status.

When training, your instructor will provide you instructions on loading and unloading while inside of your bay/s. Wait for them.

When bringing long guns onto the ranges we ask that you respect local guidelines out of respect to our neighbors:

- 1) We request that long gun muzzles are oriented downward.
- 2) Once you are on your bay training, we ask you make a concerted effort to limit high port or high ready movement when air operations are taking place.
- 3) Safety on, finger clear of the trigger guard when moving with a hot firearm.
- 4) At no time is it acceptable to flag or sweep another person on the facility or aim your muzzle towards HARB. (See below)
  - a) IF you are unloaded, you are responsible for rendering your firearm visibly clear to avoid a misunderstanding from a distance.
- 5) Your vehicle is not the place to sort your gear out meaning you may not manipulate your firearms to load or unload or fix something. We have facilities for that which are safer than your vehicle.

These policies are in order to avoid a negligent discharge resulting in an injury or a projectile leaving the range facility.
