



# LOW-LIGHT CQD

This four to six-hour course introduces individuals to the basic tactics, techniques, and procedures while using a pistol-mounted or handheld light. Students will learn how to safely and effectively enter/defend a structure and move through a building during LOW LIGHT or NO LIGHT hours. Some topics covered will be planning, structure and room layout, entry techniques, areas of responsibility, angles, and danger areas.

*LE Members & Teams are encouraged to participate.*

Part One will focus on team entry techniques. We will begin in the classroom by covering planning, approach to structure, entry points, room layouts, and the best way to approach an entry for effective movement into that room or structure. Once in the shoot house, students begin with dry run entries to ensure everyone understands the primary entry and movement principles.

Part Two will then focus on single-man entry techniques and principles while still focusing on the proper techniques for the use of cover, movement, angles, and danger areas. Most of the course will be held using SIMS, which will be supplied to each student by the instructor. After the initial classroom portion of the course, students are issued a SIMMUNITION Glock pistol, simmunition rounds, and protective equipment. Towards the end of the training day, students will go up against live role players raising realism to a new level.

*This is NOT a beginner course. Students should have a clear understanding of safe gun handling.*
