REQUIREMENTS: SHOTGUN I OR INSTRUCTOR APPROVAL

The goal is to give the intermediate or more experienced shotgun shooter the fundamentals in a low-light setting. This class concentrates on safety, marksmanship, balancing speed, and accuracy. The course also covers handheld flashlight techniques, weapon-mounted transition techniques, home defense planning, and transitions from handgun to shotgun.

Materials Required to Participate:

- Shotgun (Pump or Semi-Auto) with sling
- Pistol with 3 Magazines
- Holster
- Handheld Flashlight
- Magazine Pouch
- Eye/Ear Protection
- 100 rounds of Buck Shot Ammo
- 100 rounds of Bird Shot Ammo
- 24 rounds of Slug Ammo
- 150 rounds of Pistol Ammo
